

## CRITERION V STUDENT SUPPORT AND PROGRESSION

### 5.1 *Student Mentoring and Support*

#### 5.1.1 *Does the university have a system for student support and mentoring? If yes, what are its structural and functional characteristics?*

Yes, the University has following systems for student support:

1. Dean Student Welfare Office : Looks after students welfare.
2. Proctor office: Provides support to students.
3. Placement Cell: Helps students regarding placements.
4. Equal Opportunity Cell: Provides counselling to student regarding personality development and employment opportunities.
5. Scholarship Section: Helps the students for obtaining various scholarships.
6. Remedial coaching: Helps the weak students to overcome their deficiencies and compete with other students.
7. Coaching for entry into services: Helps the students in getting selected in various state and central services.
8. NSS officer, NCC officer : Takes the responsibility of enriching social responsibility of the students.
9. Sports department and sports officer: Guides and supports the students regarding avenues in sports and games.
10. Hostels' and hostel wardens : Hostels are available for students and wardens provide support to students residing in the hostels.
11. DCDC office : Coordinates the activities of the affiliated colleges.
12. Alumni association : Takes care of the needs of the alumni.
13. Online cell: For admissions and examination.

Different avenues for academic interaction are:

1. Interaction with HOD and teachers after classes.
2. Seminars and conferences, organized by the University.

The University has Career counselling in individual departments, DSW (Dean Students Welfare) office, Equal opportunity cell and in Placement Cell. Many companies have come and selected the students for jobs. During last four years 52 companies have visited and recruited about 429 students.

Counselling of students is done in the departments and guidance is provided for obtaining loans from the banks. Camps of banks are organized, specially during counselling for guiding and assisting students. The UCO bank branch situated near the campus which takes care of the banking needs of the students.

- \* Publication of student magazines : Sports department has student publication.

Vikram University in collaboration with MP.Govt. and Kalidas Academy organises one week long Kalidas Samorah every year on Dev Prabhodini Akadashi.
