

**Action Taken
On the Report of Peer Team on NAAC in 2002**

Actions taken on the recommendations given in the report of Peer Team of NAAC in 2008 are as follows:

Suggestion No.1: Effort may be made to fill up the vacant posts in order to strengthen the teaching and research activities.

Action Taken: In the year 2007 the 42 regular teachers (Lecturers, Readers and Professors) were appointed.

Suggestion No. 2 : Teachers need to be motivated for submitting research proposals to various funding agencies.

Action Taken: Teachers from the various departments put forward their projects to various research funding agencies like MPCST, UGC, DST, ICSSR, CSTT, UNICEF etc. on a regular basis.

Suggestion No. 3: Interaction may be promoted between the university and industries and with other universities.

Action Taken: Faculty members of various departments in the University regularly visit various Indian and foreign universities on a regular basis to share their expertise with the students and faculty members. Some departments in the university arrange industrial visits to help the students understand their job requirements in the corporate sector.

Suggestion No. 4: Self financing courses may be started for generation of funds.

Action Taken: Engineering and pharmacy are the self financing courses conducted in the University for the generation of funds.

Suggestion No. 5: Feedback from the students needs special attention.

Action Taken: Regular feedback from the students is received in order to enrich and upgrade the proposed requirements of the students regarding their suggestions.

Suggestion No. 6: Efforts may be met to strengthen communication and internet facilities in all the departments.

Action Taken: All the departments in the university have internet facility to cater to the research & communication needs of the students and the faculty members.

Suggestion No. 7: Special efforts are needed to secure funds from various government and private organizations.

Action Taken: The University is able to secure funds from various agencies through research projects and academic sponsorships.

Suggestion No. 8: The Library needs immediate attention. Funds may be made available to procure books and journals on a priority basis. The University may also subscribe to some important foreign journals in various subjects.

Action Taken: The University library seeks the lists of books from all the departments on a regular basis so that the funds allocated for the purchase of books may be used timely. The University library also subscribes online and offline journals of national and international repute.

Suggestion No. 9: In the case of the Science Schools, the infrastructure needs Up-gradation.

Action Taken: The science departments of the University are helped by the University management to procure scientific instruments, lab materials, chemicals and various other lab requirements that are needed to upgrade the infrastructural needs of the departments.

Suggestion No. 10: Streamlining of the finance department is required in order to remove unnecessary delays. The functionality of the internal audit needs to be defined.

Action Taken: University management monitors the proper streamlining of the finance so that any unnecessary delay is avoided. Auditing is regularly and timely done to avoid any discrepancy.

Suggestion No. 11: Some degree financial autonomy may be given to departments.

Action Taken: Departments in the university are allotted some funds in the form of imprest to meet the contingency needs of the departments.

Suggestion No. 12: Beautification and Cleanliness of the campus need the attention of the University . Tree plantation project may be carried out with the help of the NSS centre.

Action Taken: Every department in the University with the help of the University Maintenance Department looks after the beautification of the department. The departments with their faculty members and students actively participate in various events organized by the NSS and NCC like Tree Plantation, Clean India Mission.

Suggestion No. 13: To strengthen Science and Technology in the University, a centre for Information Science and Technology may be established.

Action Taken: With the establishment of the School of Engineering and Technology and already existing departments of Computer Science and Library Science the science and technology dimension of the university is strengthened.
