Rules and Regulations

Rules, Regulations and syllabus for Bachelor of Science
Nursing

1. The first degree in nursing course shall be designated as Bachelor of Science Nursing, abbreviated as B.Sc. Nursing.
2. This ordinance is based on revised Rules and Regulations of Indian Nursing Council, 2004(Revised). As and when these Regulations and Rules are changed by INC, the changes shall become applicable.
3. Admission to Nursing College

(A) The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 1st December of the year of admission.

(B) Qualification :-

The minimum educational requirements shall be the passing of


Higher Secondary Certificate Examination (12 Years course)

Or

Senior School Certificate Examination (10+2), Pre –degree Examination (10+2)

Or

An equivalent with 12 years schooling from a recognized Board or University with Science (Physics , Chemistry & Biology) and English with minimum of 45% aggregate marks (PCBE).


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Further 5% relaxation is permitted to SC/ST students.

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(C) Candidate shall be medically fit.

4. Entrance /Selection Test:

Selection of the candidates shall be based on the merit of the entrance examination held by the competent authority or as directed by the D.M.E. Or Nursing Council of M.P.

4. Nursing Research & statistics – Nursing Research should be of 50 marks and statistics of 25 marks.
5. Minimum pass marks shall be 40 % for English only.
6. Introduction to Computers 100 marks to be considered as total marks i.e. 25 internal and 75 external assessments. Further final examination for introduction of computer is to be conducted by the college and not by the University.
7. Minimum pass marks shall be 50% in each of the Theory and practical papers separately.
8. A candidate must have minimum of 80% attendance (irrespective of the kind of absence) in theory and practical in each subject for appearing for examination.
9. A candidate must have 100 % attendance in each of the practical areas before award of degree.
10. A candidate has to pass in theory and practical exam separately in each of the paper.
11. If a candidate fails in either theory or practical paper he/she has to re-appear for both the papers (Theory and Practical).
12. Number of attempts for examination shall be 1+4 .
13. A candidate failing in more than two subjects will not be promoted to the next year.
14. Candidate shall not be admitted to the subsequent higher examination unless the candidate has passed the previous examination.
15. The Maximum period to complete the course successfully should not exceed 8 years
16. Maximum number of candidates for practical examination should not exceed 20 per day.
17. All practical examination must be held in the respective clinical areas.
18. One internal and one external examiners should jointly conduct practical examination for each student.

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19. M.Sc.(N) qualified faculty can be made examiners for nursing and non-nursing subjects that is for Anatomy and Physiology, Psychology, Biochemistry, 4/7 Microbiology and nutrition. However non-nursing faculty can be arranged as guest lectures/ external faculty / with M.Sc qualification in respective subjects for teaching. If the examination is not conducted as per the guidelines of Indian Nursing Council it will be considered as null and void.

20. For external assessment, the University will conduct examinations.

8. Pass Marks, Divisions and Distinctions:-

First Division 60 % and above in the aggregate of marks of all main subjects.

Second Division 50% and above but less than 60% in the aggregate of marks of all main subject.

Distinction 75% and above in any subject.
(First attempt only)

Pass marks shall be 50% in individual main subject.

(Both in theory and practical separately)

Grace Marks

Grace marks the grace should not exceed 5 Marks in total for one academic year in theory paper only. Grace of one mark in supplementary examination.

9. Supplementary Examination:-

(A) There will be only one mid session supplementary Examination held by University in the month of Jan/Feb. In this Supplementary Examination, even the failed subjects will be also examined. There will be another supplementary Examination at the time of Annual main examination.

(B) The first year students will have to clear all 1st year subjects in a maximum limit of 4 attempts after which they will not be allowed to continue their B.Sc.

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19. M.Sc.(N) qualified faculty can be made examiners for nursing and non-nursing subjects that is for Anatomy and Physiology, Psychology, Biochemistry, 4/7 Microbiology and nutrition. However non-nursing faculty can be arranged as guest lectures/ external faculty / with M.Sc qualification in respective subjects for teaching. If the examination is not conducted as per the guidelines of Indian Nursing Council it will be considered as null and void.

20. For external assessment, the University will conduct examinations.

8. Pass Marks, Divisions and Distinctions:-

First Division	60 % and above in the aggregate of marks of all main subjects.
Second Division	50% and above but less than 60% in the aggregate of marks of all main subject.
Distinction	75% and above in any subject. (First attempt only)

Pass marks shall be 50% in individual main subject.



- (C) If a 1st year candidate fails in mid session supplementary papers , she will be given an opportunity to appear in the main examination of 2nd year provisionally along with the backlog last year subject.
- (D) If a candidate fails in backlog subjects of the 1st year the result of 2nd year examination for which she was provisionally admitted His/her result will be withheld until He or she clear His/her backlog paper.
- (E) A candidate who appears in 2nd year main examination and fails in any of the subjects will be permitted to appear in mid session supplementary examination and there after in the annual main examination of the 3rd year also provisionally along with failed 2nd year subject, if any. But if she fails on 2nd year subject her 3rd year result will be with held. The same ruling will apply for the 4th year students also.
- (F) Only Two subjects Failed Student will have to be repeated in mid session supplementary or Supplementary examination with the main annual examination.
- (G) The marks obtained by the candidate in the subjects passed in supplementary examination attempt shall be taken into account in determining the division at the examination.

Merit List

1. Marks of computers will not be counted for merit list.
2. The Candidate passed in first attempt will be included in merit list.
3. Candidates obtaining ranks from 1 to 10 will be included in merit list.

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10. Essentiality Certificate:

1. Govt. order for enhancement of seats is not necessary for any nursing programme , However Govt order is mandatory to start ANM/GNM/B.Sc. (N) nursing programme .The seats for the nursing institution can be sanctioned more than government order , Provided the institution is having physical, clinical and teaching facilities as per the INC norms

2. If the institution is recognized for B.Sc. (N) programme and if one batch has passed out found suitable ,then the Institution will be exempted from NOC/Essentiality certificate for M.Sc. (N) programme from the state government.

3. External lecturer for non -nursing subject faculty should possess post graduate qualification in the respective subject and should have minimum of 3 years of teaching experience.

4. Super -speciality hospitals is permitted to starts M.Sc. (N) programme, without having under graduate programme however they have to obtain NOC/ Essentiality Certificate from respective state government to start the M.Sc. (N) programme.

5. NOC / Essentiality Certificate is exempted for the institutions for P.B.BSc.(N) Programme if and only if the institution is offering B.Sc. (N) programme and is approved by the Indian Nursing Council.

6. Institutions shall recruit the teaching faculty as per the prescribed qualification by Indian Nursing Council for respective programme

7. The examination and declaration of results should be within the academic year.

.This post graduate programme is essential to prepare nurses to improve the quality of nursing education ,administration and research practice in India.

Aim

The aim of the postgraduate program in nursing is to prepare graduates to assume responsibilities as specialists, consultants, educators, administrators in a wide variety of professional settings.

Objectives

On completion of the two year M.Sc. Nursing programme ,the post graduate will be able to:-

1. Utilize / apply the concepts, theories and principles of nursing sciences.
2. Demonstrate advance competence in practice of nursing.
3. Practice as a nurse specialist.
4. Demonstrate leadership qualities and function effectively as nurse educator and manager.
5. Demonstrate skill in conducting nursing research, interpreting and utilizing the findings from health related research.
6. Demonstrate the ability to plan and effect change in nursing practice and in health care delivery system.
7. Establish collaborative relationship with members of other disciplines.
8. Demonstrate interest in continued learning for personal and professional advancement.

Eligibility Criteria /Admission Requirements:

1. The candidate should be a Registered Nurse and Registered midwife or equivalent with any state Nursing Registration Council.
2. The minimum education requirements shall be the passing of :
B.Sc. Nursing/ B.Sc. Hons.Nursing /Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with minimum of 55% aggregate marks.
3. The candidate should have undergone in B.Sc. Nursing / B.Sc. Hons. Nursing/ post Basic B.Sc. Nursing in an institution which is recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
4. Minimum one year of work experience after Basic B.Sc. Nursing.
5. Minimum one year of work experience prior or after post Basic B.Sc. Nursing.
6. Candidate shall be medically fit.
7. 5% relaxation of marks for SC/ST candidates may be given.

Entrance /Selection test

Selection of the candidates shall be based on the merit of the entrance examination held by the competent authority or as directed by the D.M.E. Or Nursing Council of M.P

Regulations for examination:

Eligibility for appearing for the examination:

75% of the attendance for theory and practical. However 100% of attendance for practical before the award of degree.

Classification of results:

- 50% pass in each of the theory and practical separately.

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- 50-59 % Second division
- 60-74 % first division
- 75% and above is distinction
- For declaring the rank aggregate of 2 Years marks to be considered.

If the candidate fails in either practicals or theory paper he/she has to reappear for both the papers (theory and practical)

Maximum no. of attempts per subject is three (3) exclusive of first attempt. The maximum period to complete the course successfully should not exceed 4 years.

Candidate, who fails in any subject, shall be permitted to continue the studies into the second year. However the candidate shall not be allowed to appear for the second year examination till such time that he/she passes all subjects of the first year M.Sc. nursing examination.

Practicals

- 4 hours of practical examination per student.
- Maximum number of 10 students per day per speciality .
- The examination should be held in clinical area only for clinical specialities.
- One internal and external should jointly conduct practical examination.
- Examiner –Nursing faculty teaching respective speciality area in M.Sc. nursing programme with minimum 3 years experience after M.Sc. nursing.


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
